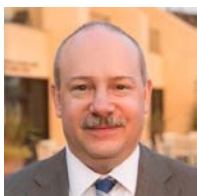

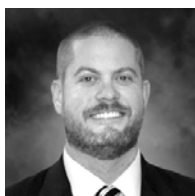

Ron Ross is a Fellow at the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST). His areas of specialization include information security and risk management. Ross leads the Federal Information Security Management Act (FISMA) Implementation Project.
